- (A) If you checked box(H) on Form CC 375M, check the box for "Ex Parte."
- (B) Fill in the "Case No." from Form CC 375M.
- Fill in the "petitioner" and "respondent" the same way you did on Form CC 375. If you want your address and telephone number to be kept from the respondent, do not write your address here. Put in the address of a relative or friend or a post office box where the court can contact you.
- Write in the respondent's name and as much of the other information as you know. This information will help the police to identify the respondent if he or she disobeys the restraining order. Be sure to identify the respondent accurately. The race, sex, and date of birth are required for law enforcement to enter an order on the Law Enforcement Information Network (LEIN).
- (E) Write in the name(s) and address(es) of the respondent's parent(s), guardian(s), or custodian(s).

The court will complete the rest of this form.

NOTE: There are only 6 copies of this form. You will need to make extra copies of this form for each parent, guardian, or custodian of the respondent.

You must read the booklet "Instructions for Personal Protection Orders" for directions on the legal process.

- If you asked for an ex parte order (order without a hearing), read pages 3 and 4 of the booklet.
- If you did not ask for an ex parte order or the judge refuses to sign an ex parte order, read pages 5 and 6
 of the booklet.
